

Privacy and Data Protection

Data protection

The operators of this website take the protection of your personal data very seriously. We handle your personal data in full confidentiality and in accordance with the statutory data protection regulations as well as this privacy policy.

It should usually be possible to use our website without providing personal information. Whenever personal information (such as names, addresses or email addresses) is collected on our website, it will as far as possible be on a voluntary basis. The information will not be given to third parties without your explicit permission.

We would like to point out that the transfer of data over the internet (for example, when communicating by email) can present security risks. It is not possible to provide complete protection of data from access by third parties.

Data protection declaration for the use of Google Analytics

This website uses functions of the web analytics service Google Analytics. The provider is Google Inc. 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA. Google Analytics uses "cookies". These are text files that are stored on your computer and enable analysis of your use of the website. The information generated by cookies about your use of this website will generally be transferred to a Google server in the USA and stored there.

If IP anonymisation is activated on this website, your IP address will be truncated within member states of the European Union or other parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Cookies

Parts of our website use so-called cookies. Cookies do not harm your computer and do not contain viruses. They serve to make our website more user-friendly, efficient and secure. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer and saved by your browser.

Most of the cookies we use are so-called "session cookies". They are automatically deleted after your visit. Other cookies remain in the memory of your device until you delete them. These cookies allow us to recognise your browser the next time you visit.

You can configure your browser to inform you about the use of cookies so that you can decide to accept or reject each cookie. Alternatively, your browser can automatically accept cookies under certain conditions or always reject them, and you can also tell it to automatically delete cookies when closing your browser. If cookies are deactivated, the functionality of this website may be restricted.
